1. Statements may be made under the "Public Forum" section of the meeting agenda. Please state your name, address, and name of any organization represented. Comments and questions may deal with any topic related to the operation of the schools or meeting agenda items, except complaints about specific school personnel (which may be handled in a non-public session to avoid legal damages to all involved).

With due respect to citizens and in order to assure adequate study of questions, arising board members should not be expected to discuss issues presented at this time. Limited discussion may take place to simply clarify concerns if necessary.

2. Visitors may also speak at the time the Board discusses any agenda item by submitting a written request to the Board President prior to the start of the School Board Meeting (Policy No. 187). Cards will be available in the board room for making this written request. Comments will be heard following the Board's discussion and prior to a vote being taken, with a 3-minute time limit for any one visitor.

Persons wishing to address the Board on a specific issue for formal response by the Board should contact the Superintendent of Schools and request to be placed on the agenda for a regular meeting. Such request should be made at least five days in advance of the regular meeting date.
