The Muskego-Norway Schools is thrilled to announce that Lakeview Elementary School has earned a 2014-15 Wisconsin Title I School of Recognition Award. This acknowledgement, given by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction and State Superintendent Tony Evers, is awarded to three types of schools: 1) high-achieving; 2) high-progress; and 3) beating the odds. Lakeview Elementary School received the high achieving award. Lakeview is one of only 16 schools in the state of Wisconsin receiving the high achieving award.

All Wisconsin Title I Schools of Recognition receive federal Title I aid because they have significant numbers of students from low-income families based on federal free- and reduced-price school meal income guidelines. Also, all Schools of Recognition meet the state's test-participation, attendance, and dropout goals. Additional award criteria for high-achieving schools include: 1) meeting all Annual Measurable Objectives (AMOs) for achievement and graduation; 2) having achievement gaps that are less than three percentage points between student groups or show evidence of reducing gaps greater than three percentage points; and 3) demonstrating high achievement at the school level.

Each award-winning school will receive:

- recognition at a reception and ceremony in Madison on Monday, October 13, 2014;
- a plaque recognizing its accomplishment;
- \$500 for school-related purposes;
- an award logo for use in its communications; and
- the opportunity for its teachers to participate in a Teacher Fellowship program.

Alan Groth, principal of Lakeview Elementary, commented, "Lakeview teachers, parents and district support staff have dedicated themselves to ensure that every student is working to their potential and fulfilling our district's mission. We love what we do and are committed to the success of everyone, every day."
