Here's what you need to have on file prior to participating in any practices or tryouts:

- **PHYSICAL EXAM CARD** \* (salmon): Anyone who desires to participate in the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Program (WIAA) must have their physical exam information card on file in the Activities Office prior to the first day of practice. All incoming 9<sup>th</sup> grade athletes **MUST HAVE a new** physical in order to participate. A licensed physician must sign the appropriate form. The blue Pupil's Health Examination Form included in the orientation packet **CANNOT** be substituted for the WIAA physical exam card. Please note: Per WIAA rule, an examination taken **BEFORE APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup>** is valid for the remainder of the current school year and the following school year. An examination taken **AFTER APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup>** is good for the following TWO school years. Please schedule your exam after April 1<sup>st</sup>.
- **ALTERNATE YEAR CARD** \* (gold): Must be completed on the alternate year. Alternate year is the second year of a physical taken after April 1st.
- **CODE CARD** \* (gray): Outlines the behavioral expectations for students participating in our activities program. (One per school year)
- **EMERGENCY CARD** (green): An athletic emergency card must be filled out for **EACH** sport.

This card is kept with the coach at all times.

- “Sideline For Safety Act 172” Form\*. Acknowledgement of having received education about the signs, symptoms and the risks of sport related concussion. (One for each sport)
- Payment of \$75.00/sport (\$150.00 maximum for student).

**\*THESE CARDS REQUIRE TWO SETS OF SIGNATURES**

The forms listed above can be picked up in the activities office. Also, coaches have sign-up meetings prior to their seasons and have these forms available at that time to give to the students.

Please note that due to the sheer volume of sports participation in the fall, we have special dates to collect these forms and payments just prior to the start of the fall season. We call that our “Fall Athletic Registration”. No cards are accepted prior to these dates.
