

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The School Board shall provide access to and encourage full participation in co-curricular and recreational activities and programs for elementary, middle and high school students. Full participation means fair and equal participation to the extent that the budget, facilities or type of activity allows.

The schools shall have a complementary relationship to the home and the community whereby the schools plan a school program with due regard for the wide and rich facilities already available to students. The assistance of parents/guardians in planning the school's activity programs shall be encouraged.

The Muskego-Norway School District shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage on the basis of sex, race, national origin, ancestry, color, creed, religion, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures as outlined in School Board Policy 411.

New program requests shall be submitted in writing to the Activities Coordinator by October 1 for the following school year. The Activities Coordinator or designee will forward the request to a district team consisting of the superintendent, principal and Title IX Coordinator. The team will consider the following criteria: financial impact, facilities, student interest, qualified coaching candidates, Title IX, impact on existing MNSD approved programs, availability of opponents or other school participants.
