

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

The goal of student transportation within the Muskego-Norway School District is to provide a safe, efficient, and fiscally responsible system of student transportation. Transportation shall be provided for the following:

- All students regularly enrolled in the Muskego-Norway School District.
- Private school students in accordance with state law.

In the morning, the district's responsibility for individual students begins with a rider's bus pick-up and ends with a rider's school drop-off. In the afternoon, the district's responsibility begins with a rider's school pick-up and ends with a rider's designated drop-off.

Transportation shall be provided to riders who abide by the established bus conduct rules and regulations. Failure to observe such rules and regulations may result in denial of bus riding privileges.

The Director of Business Services shall be responsible for the administration of the transportation program in accordance with established procedures.
