

Muskego-Norway School District Community Survey Results

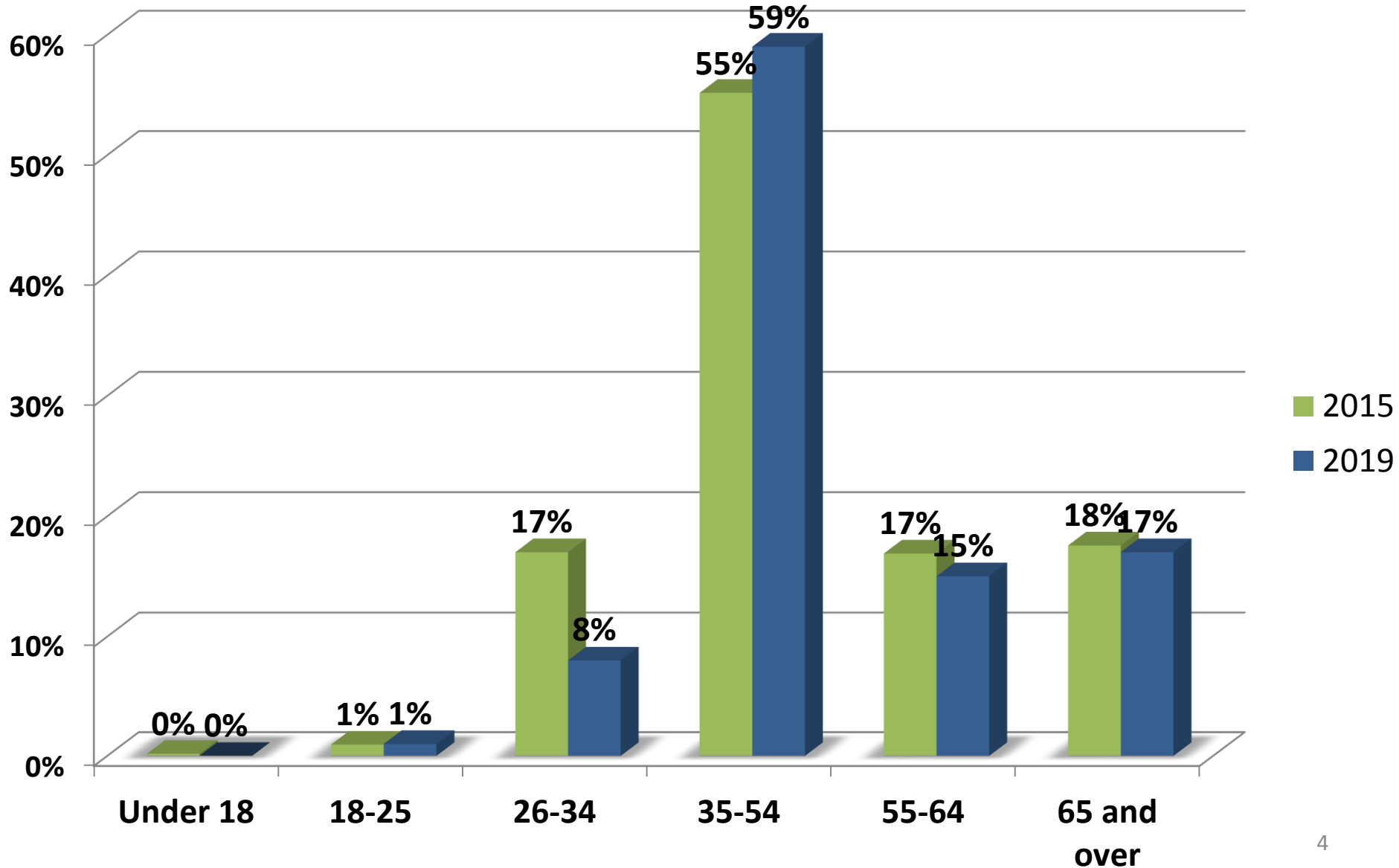

Survey Summary

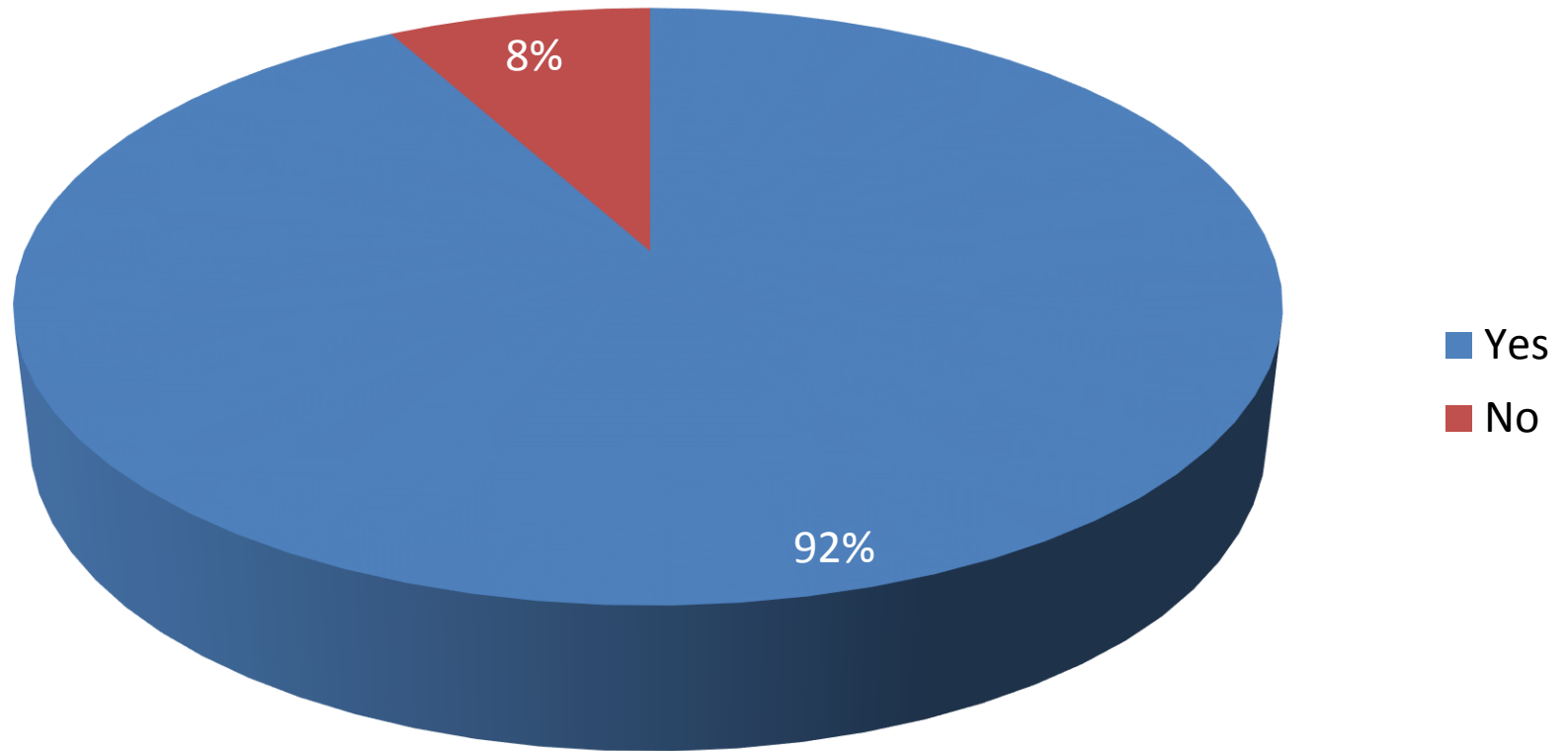
- The survey was conducted in April of 2019.
- Residents within the District were mailed a paper survey. Each survey included a unique survey access code for those who preferred to take the survey online.
- Total responses = 2,269 (734 paper)
- Response rate = 18% (23% in 2015)
- Margin of error = +/- 2.1%

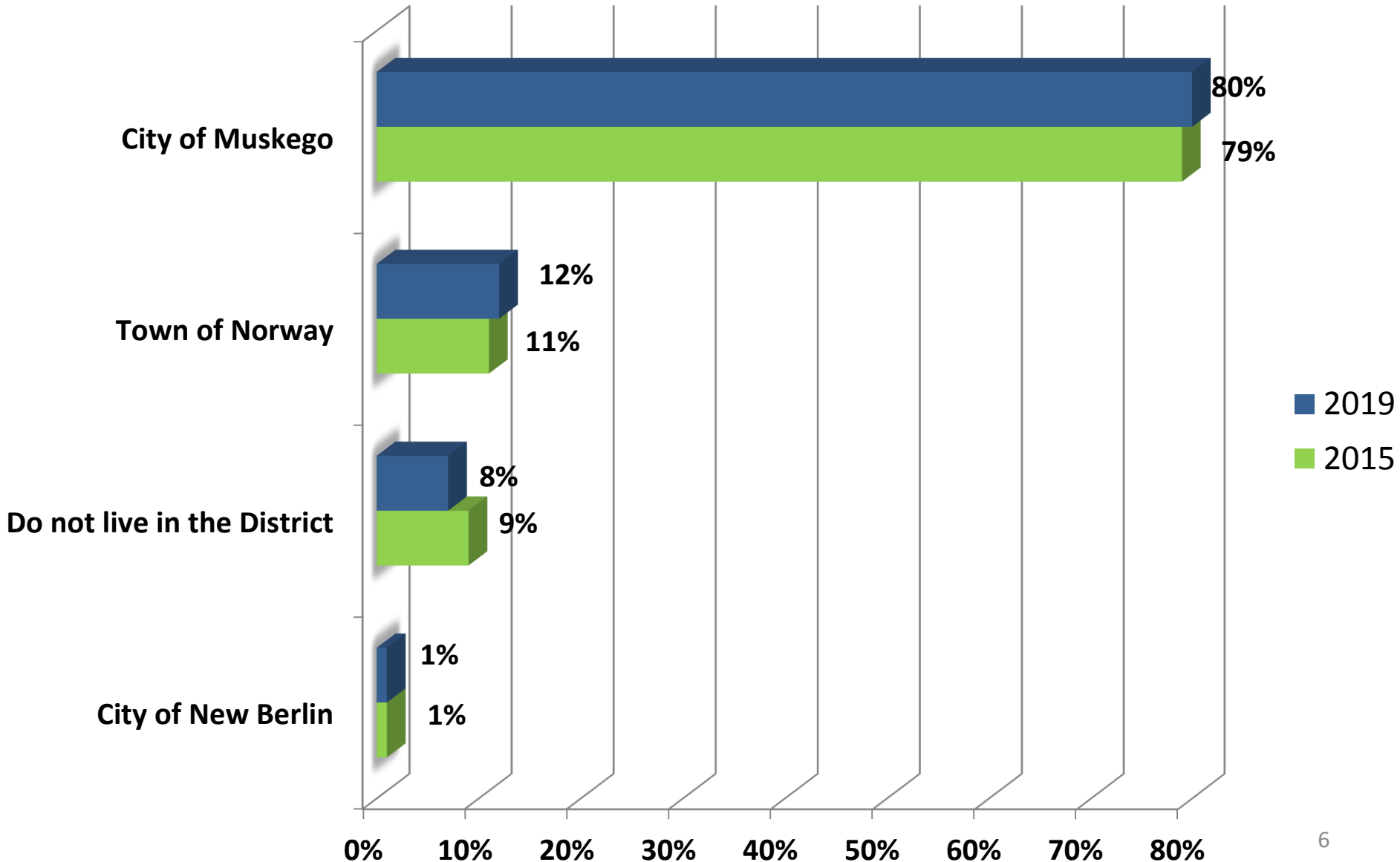
What is your age?



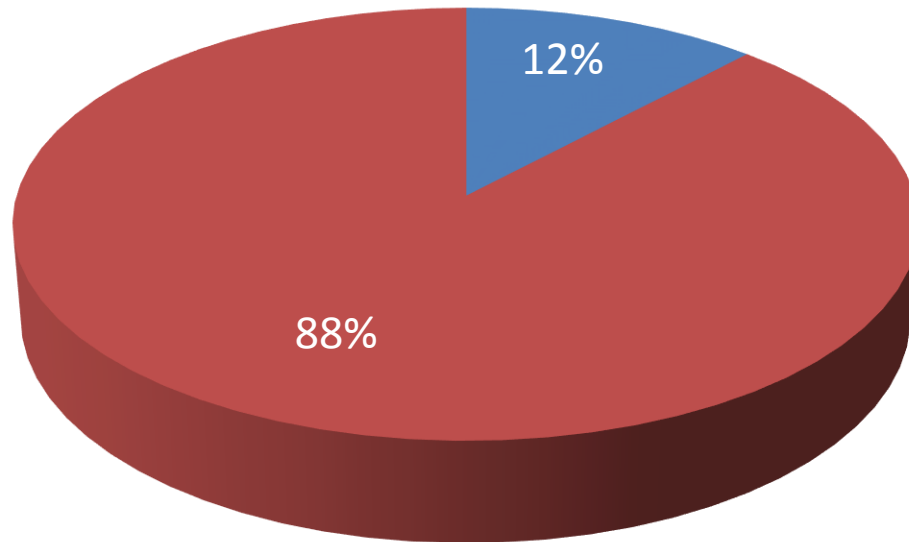
Do you live in the Muskego-Norway School District?



In which city or township do you reside?

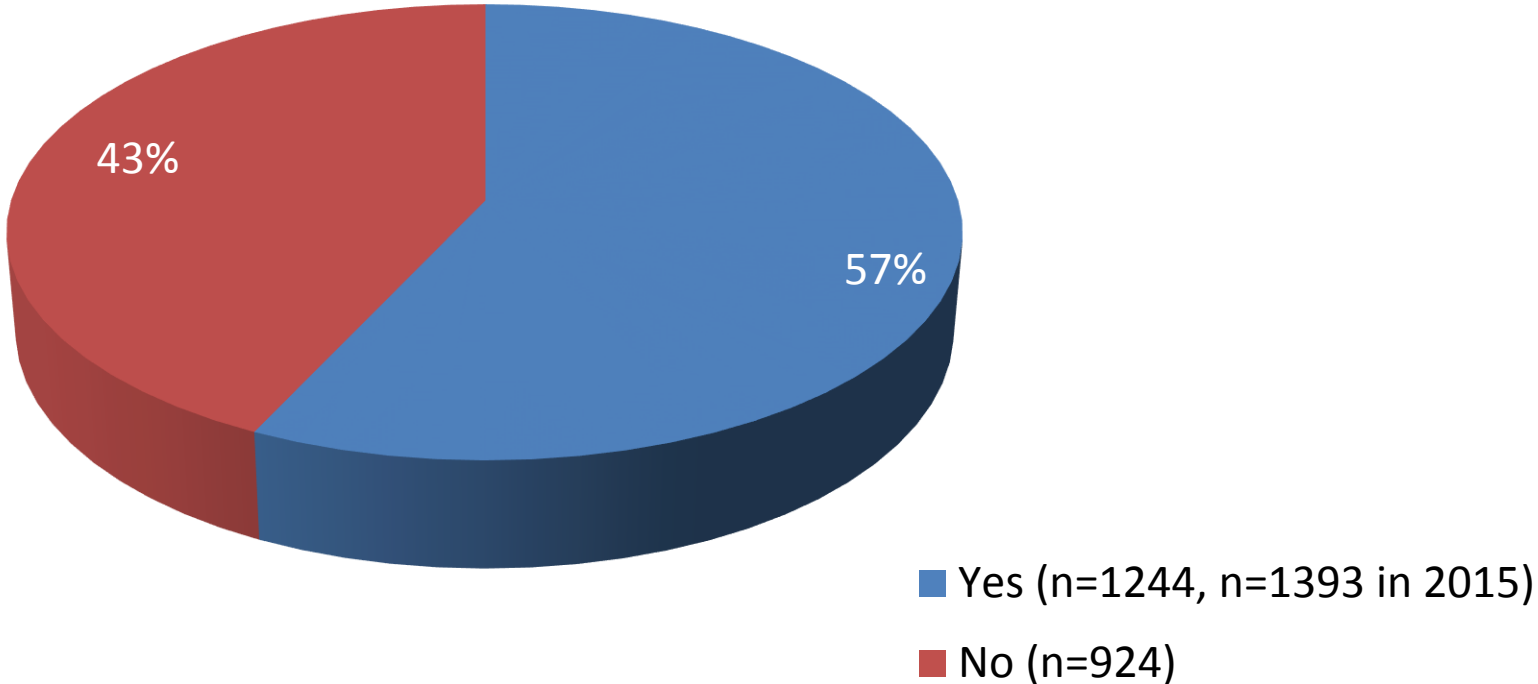


Are you an employee of the Muskego-Norway School District?

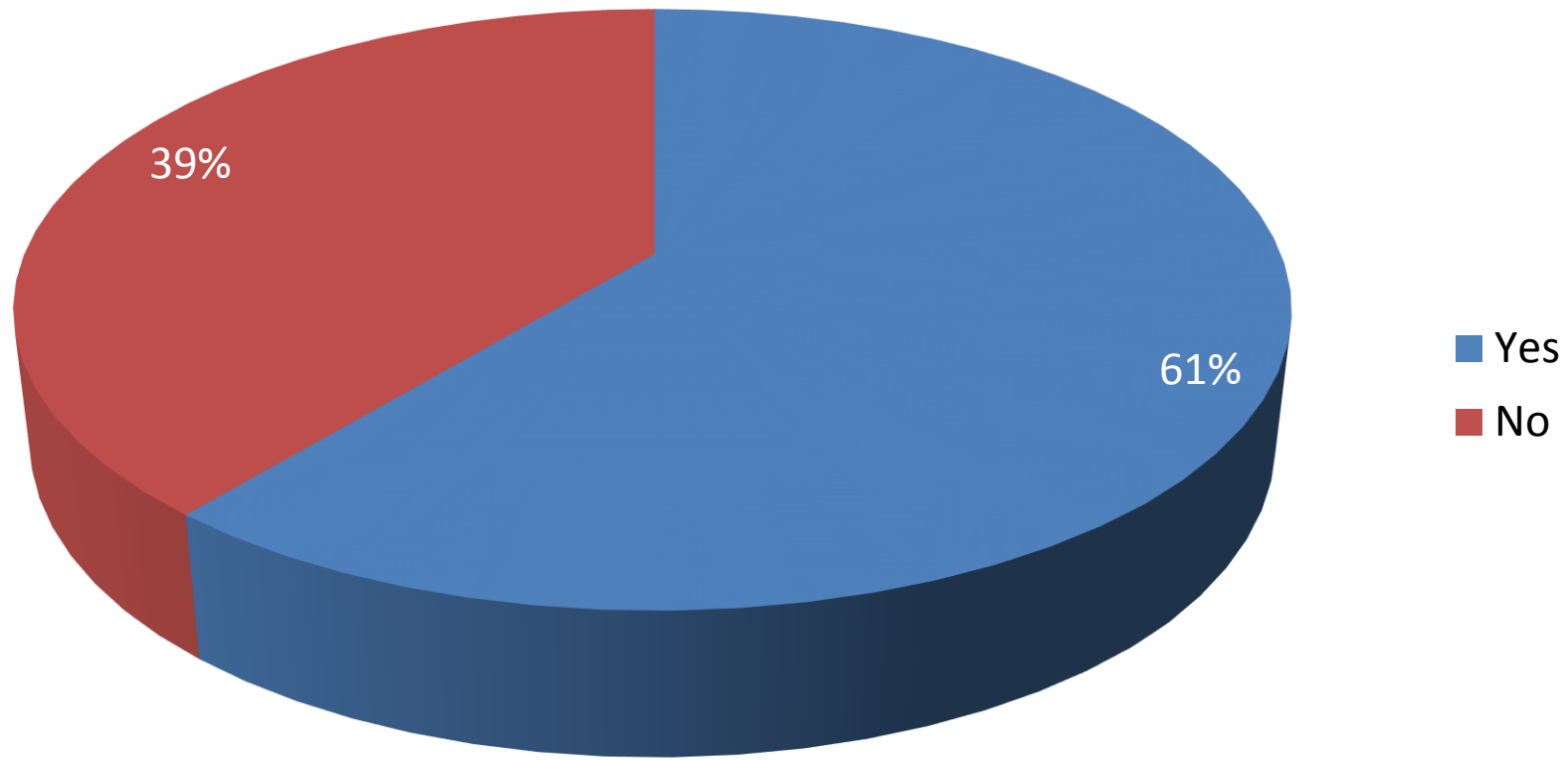

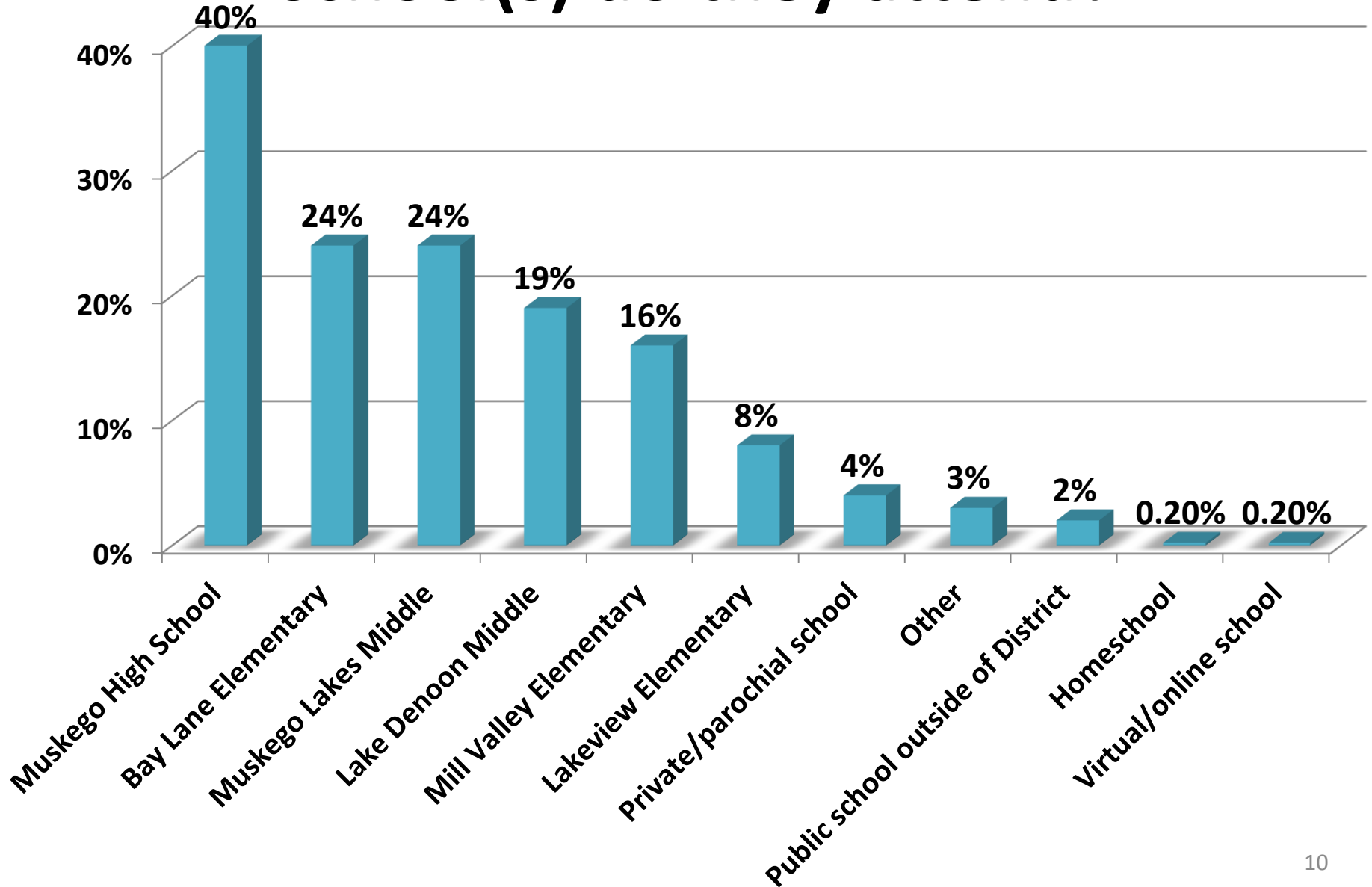
Do you have child(ren) attending school in the District?



If you have school-aged children, do they participate in any school-sponsored sports and/or extracurricular activities?

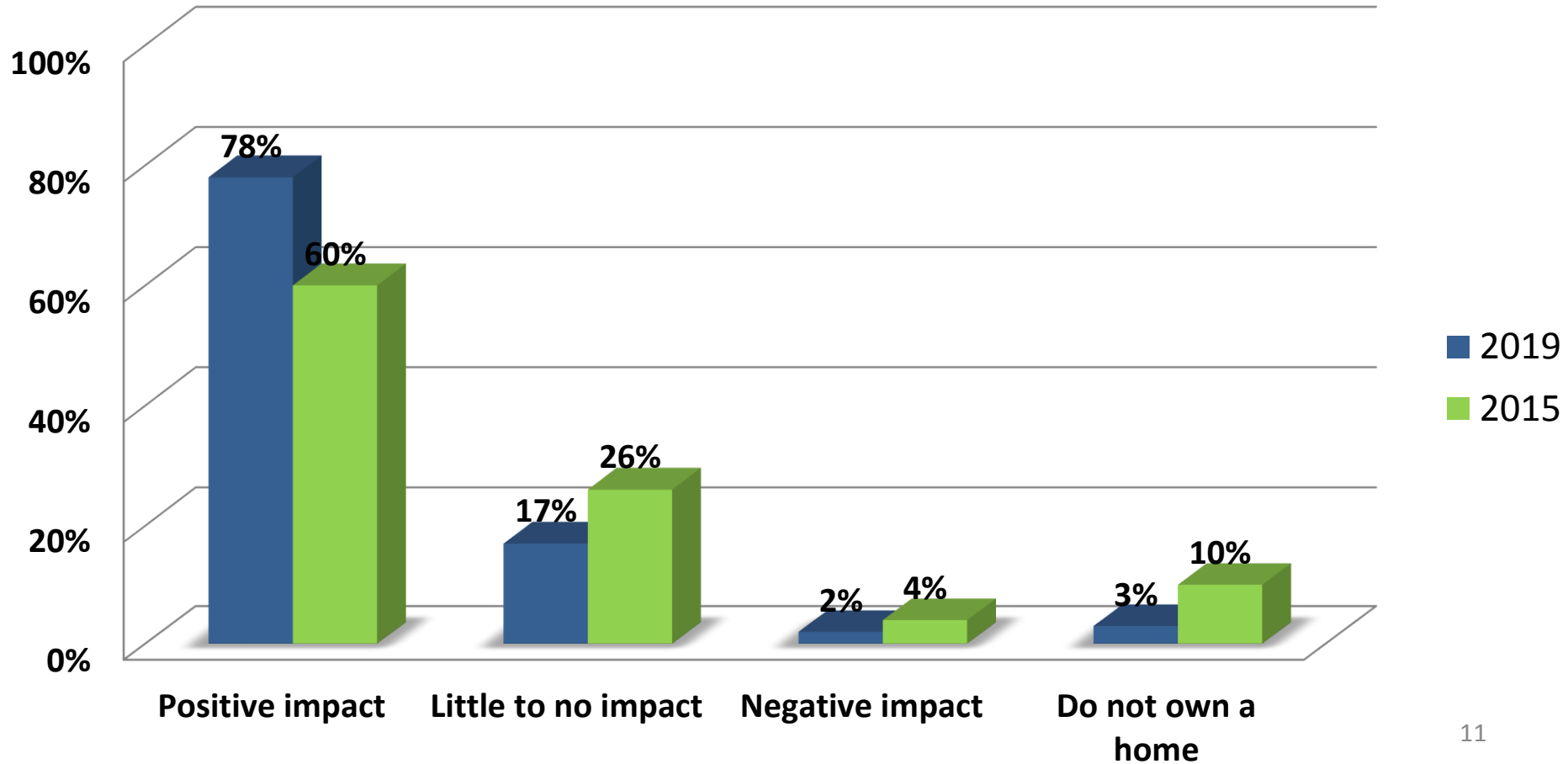


If you have school-aged children, what school(s) do they attend?

Facility Planning Background

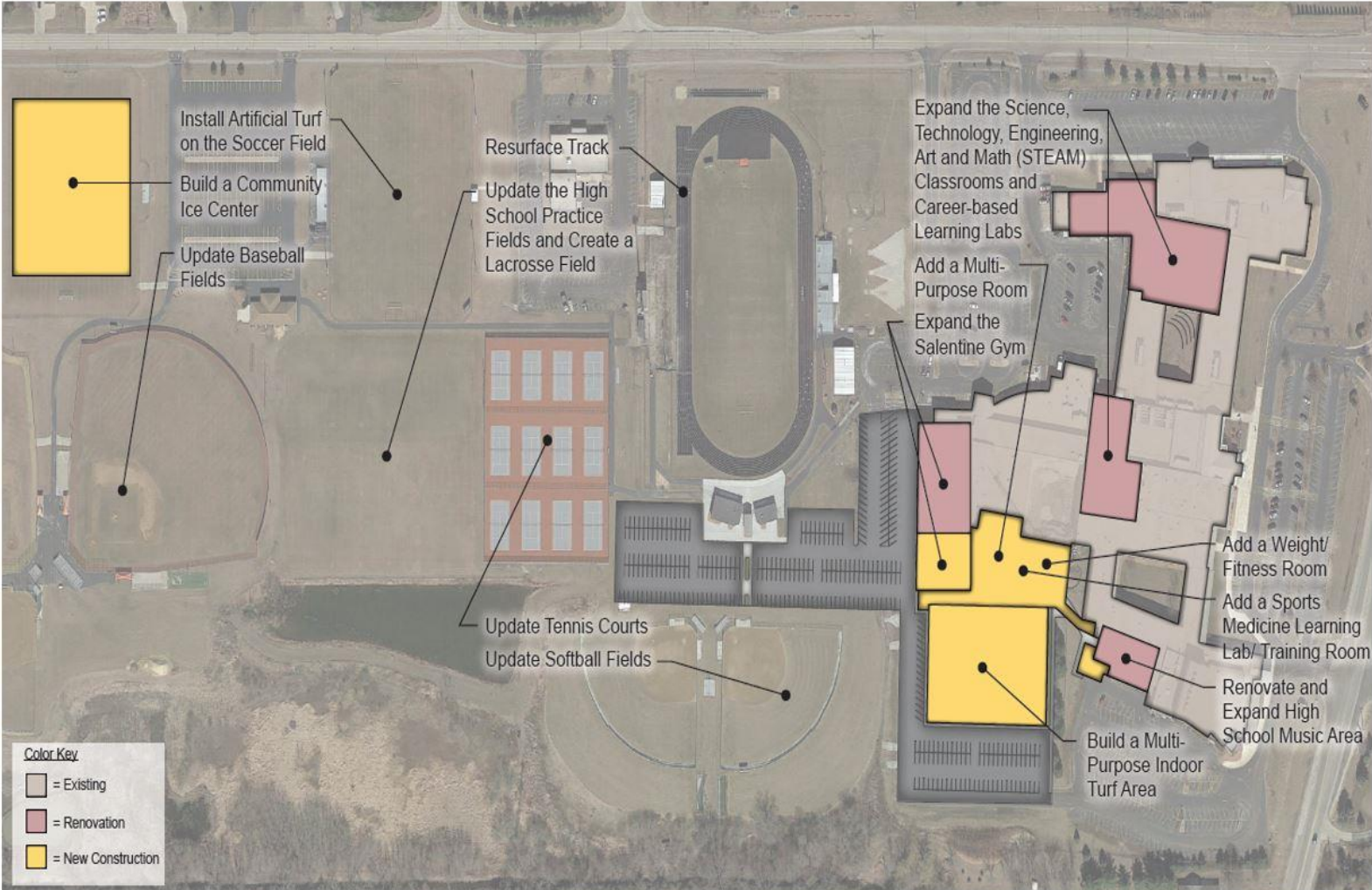
We are very thankful for our community's ongoing support of our schools, including the approval of the 2016 referendum. This funding allowed the District to build a new middle school and update our other schools. We are happy to report that these projects were completed on time and within budget.

Since that time, the District has been able to address a number of additional projects through other funding sources including fundraising, grants, the District's operational budget and sponsorships. Some of these projects include:

- Installing a high-speed fiber optic network
- Installing concessions, restrooms, bleachers, artificial turf and a scoreboard at the football field
- Updating the swimming pool

Facility Master Planning

There are a number of other projects that have been brought forward by staff, parents and community members that could be included in the next phase of the District's Facility Master Plan. Our goal is to determine the community's priorities for each of the potential projects identified in the image below.

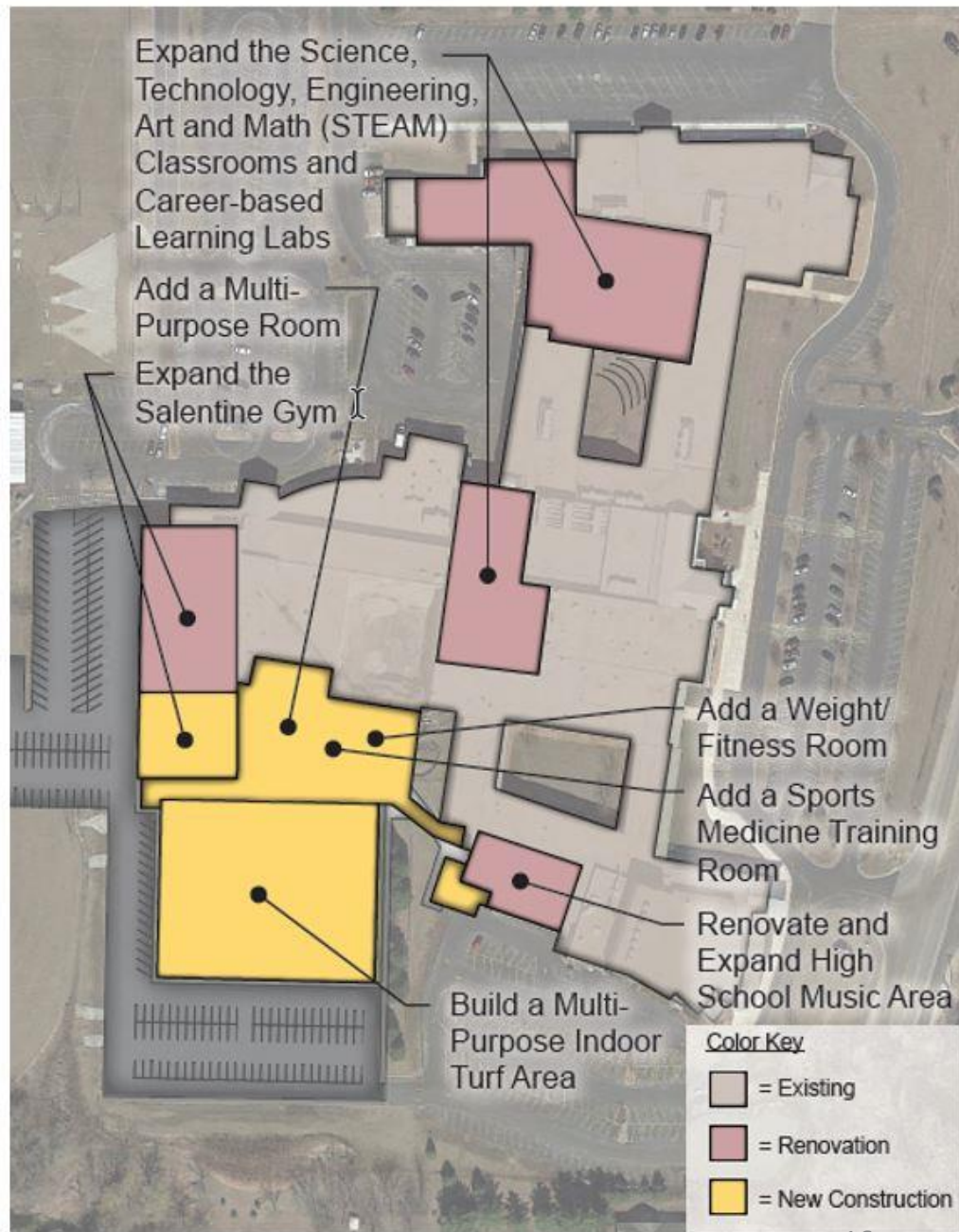


High School: STEAM Classrooms and Career-based Learning Labs

There is a growing demand for skilled professionals in the fields of Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Math (STEAM). In response, the District would like to expand course offerings in engineering, manufacturing, business, marketing, design, health sciences, building trades, auto repair and computer science.

The current classrooms and labs for these offerings are too small and lack the flexibility needed to incorporate the latest technology and equipment.

In order to expand the STEAM and Tech. Ed courses, **additional space will be needed**. The North Gym, weight room and adjacent areas used for wrestling, dance and yoga are the most logical areas to repurpose. If these changes are made, the Salentine Gym as well as adjacent spaces will need to be expanded to replace the remodeled space.

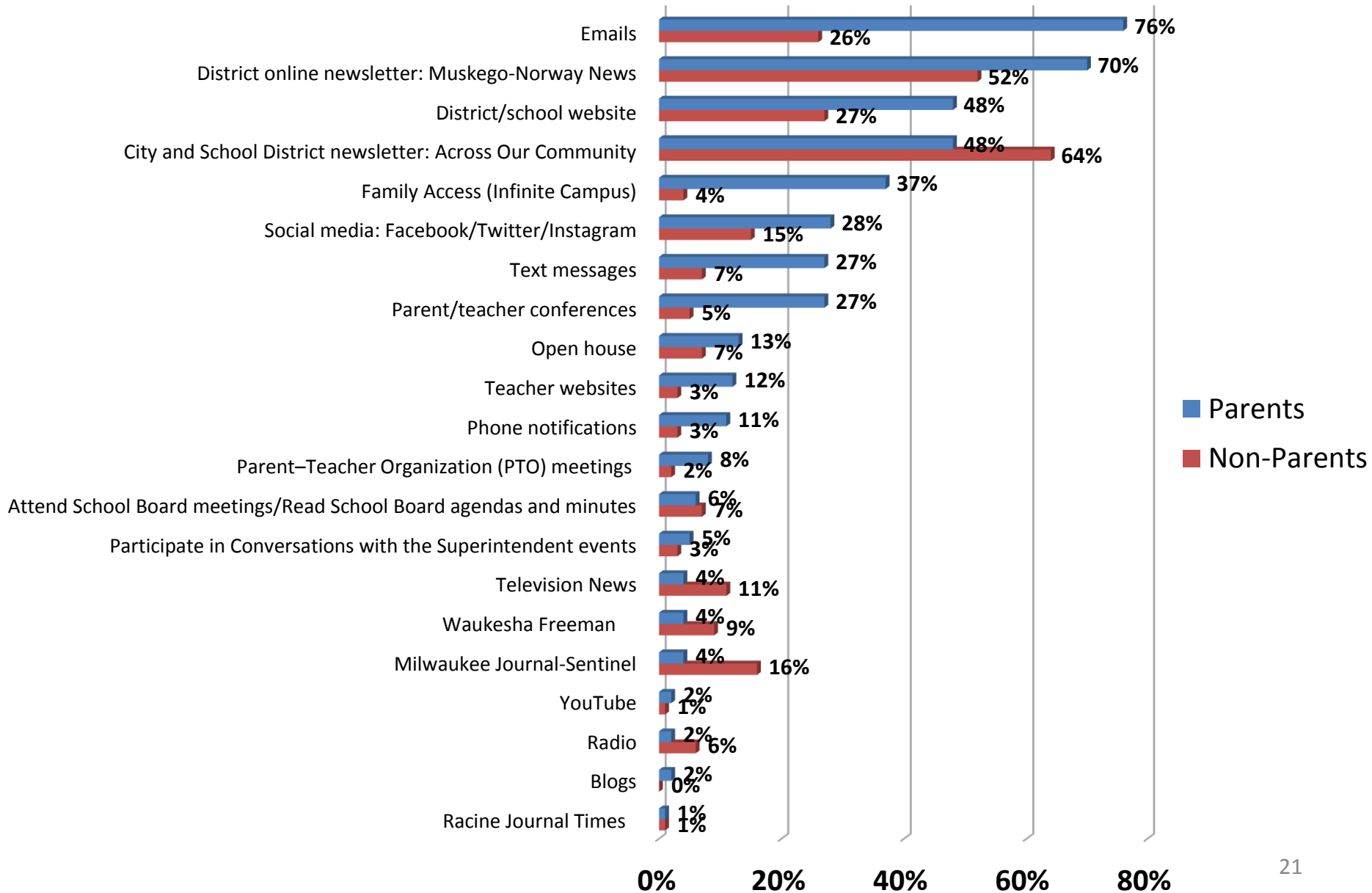

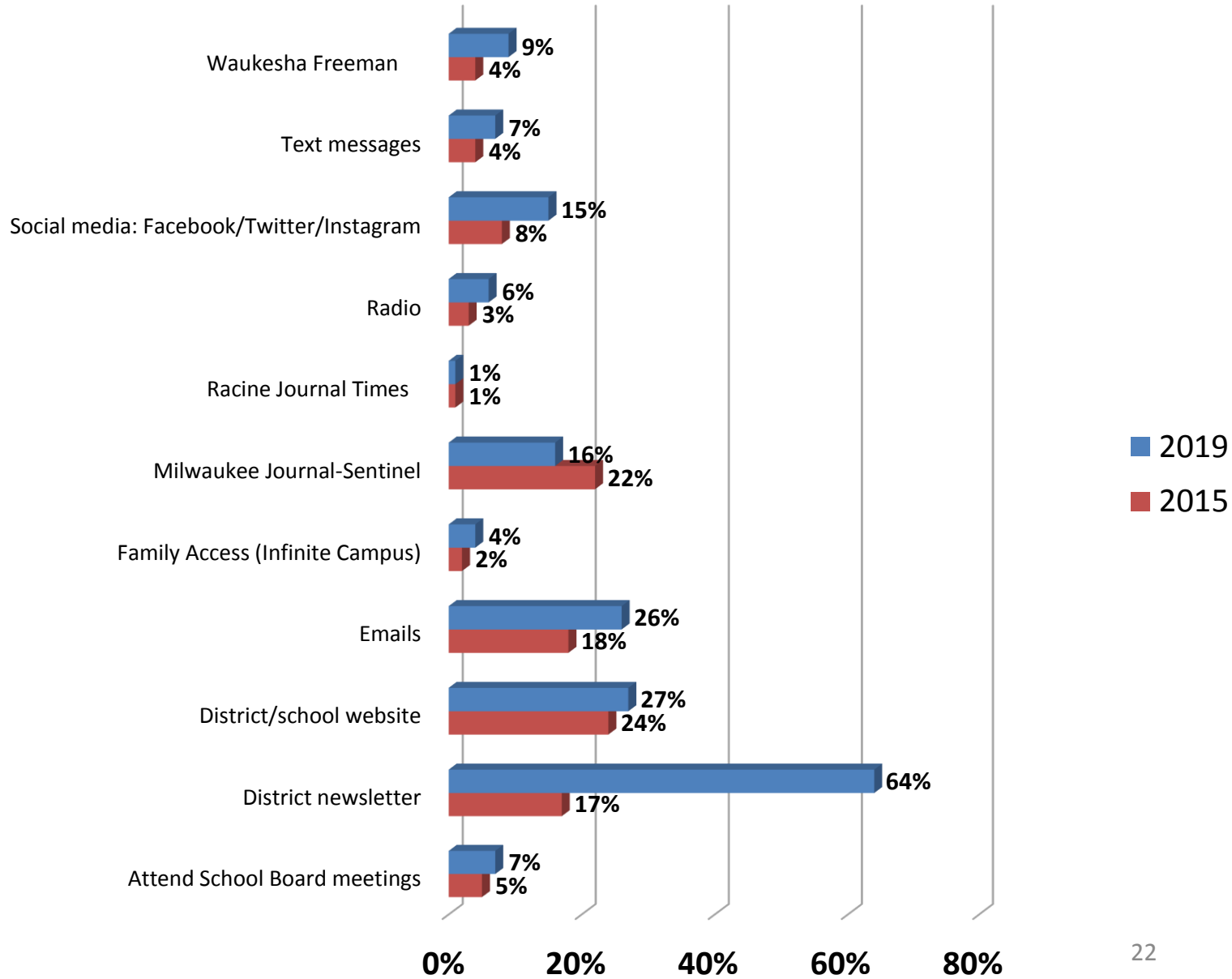

How would you like to receive school information?



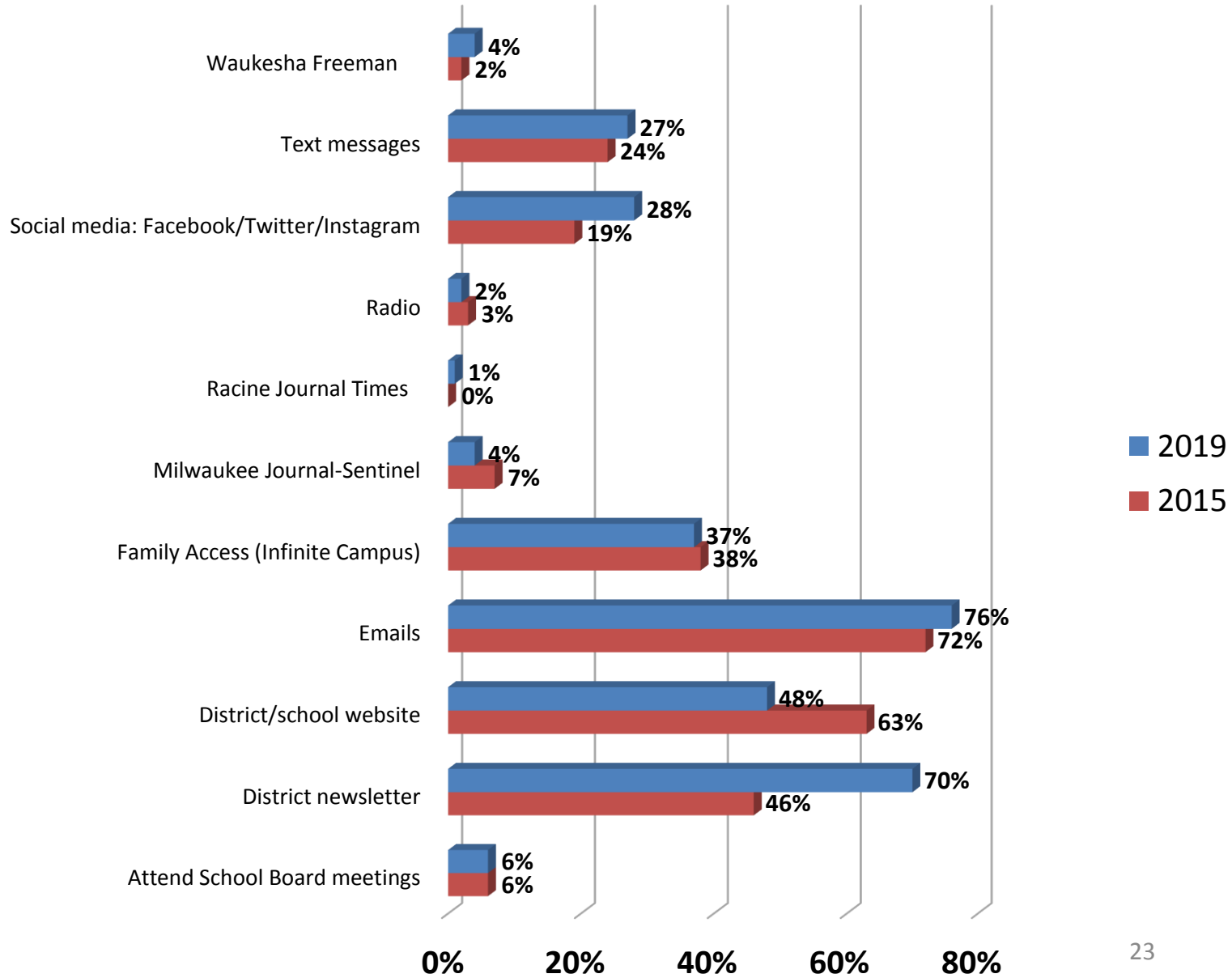

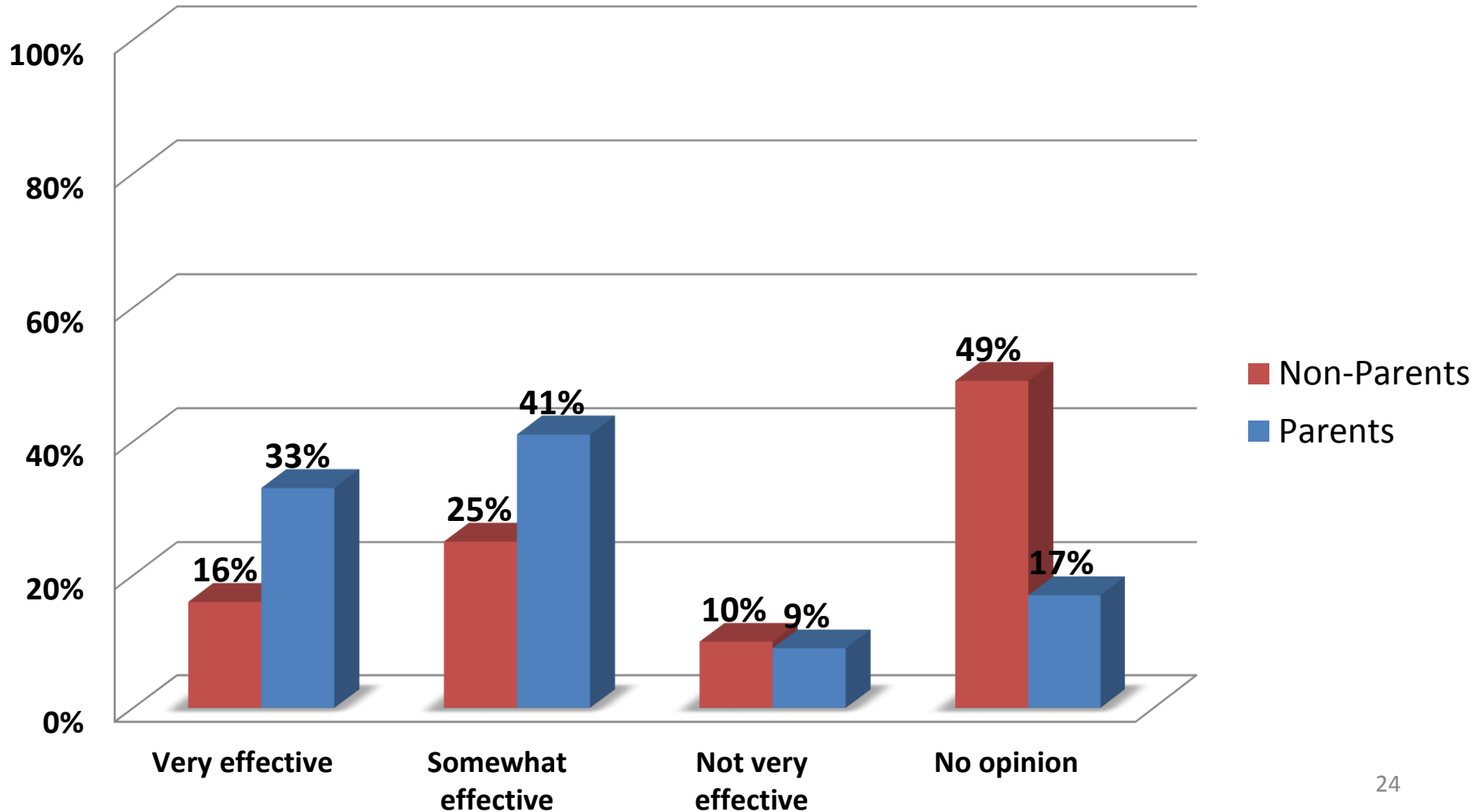

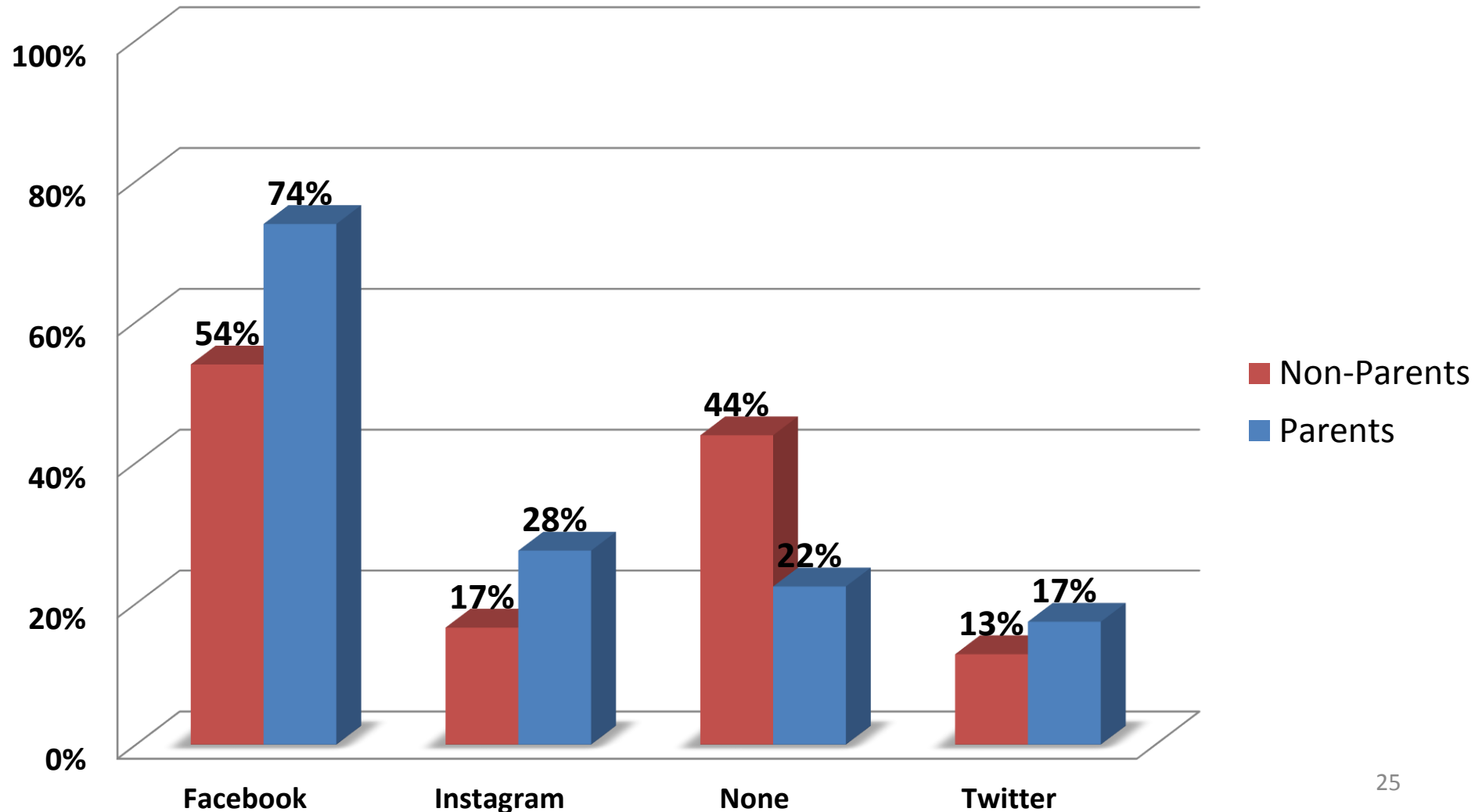

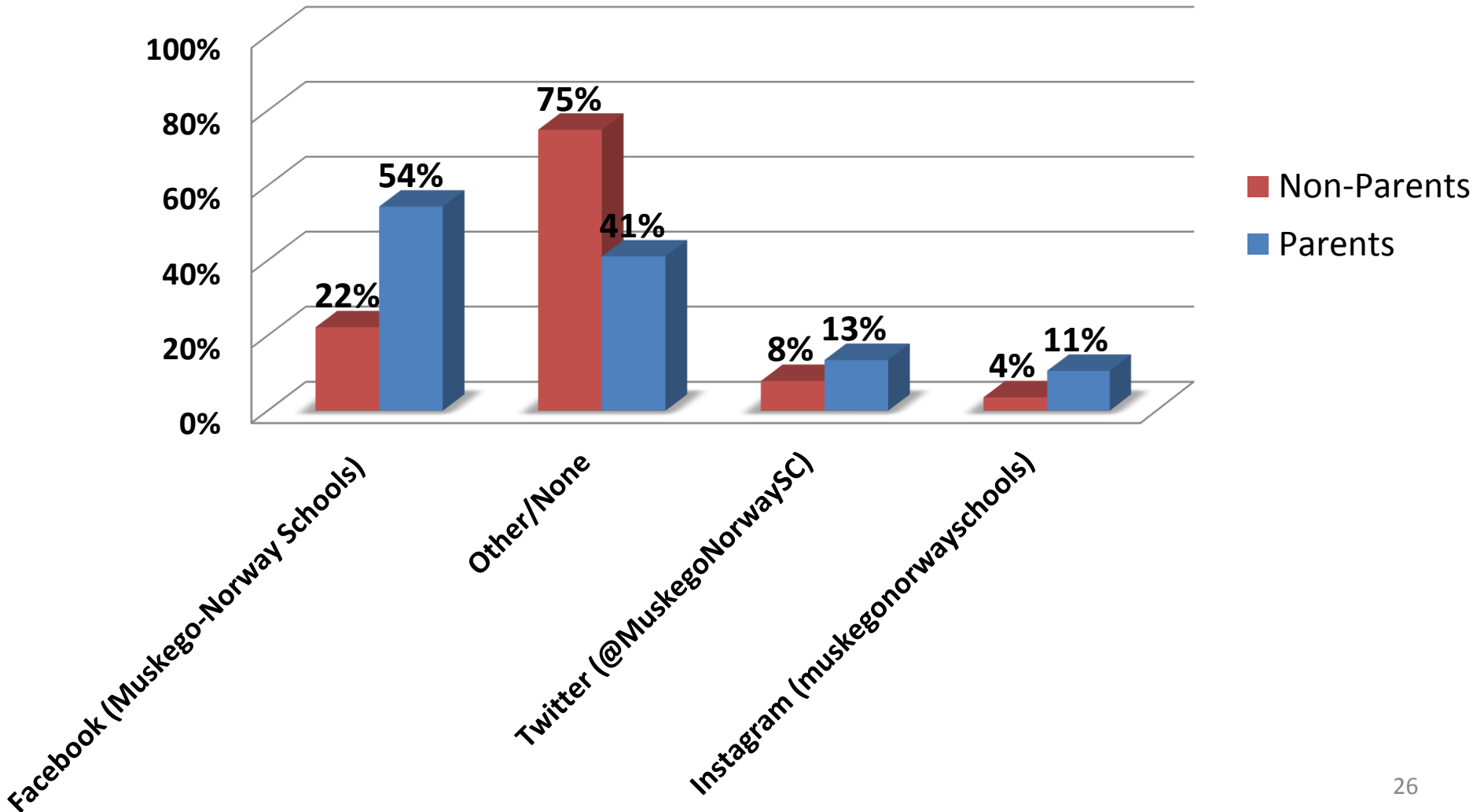
How effective is the District's website in providing timely and meaningful information?



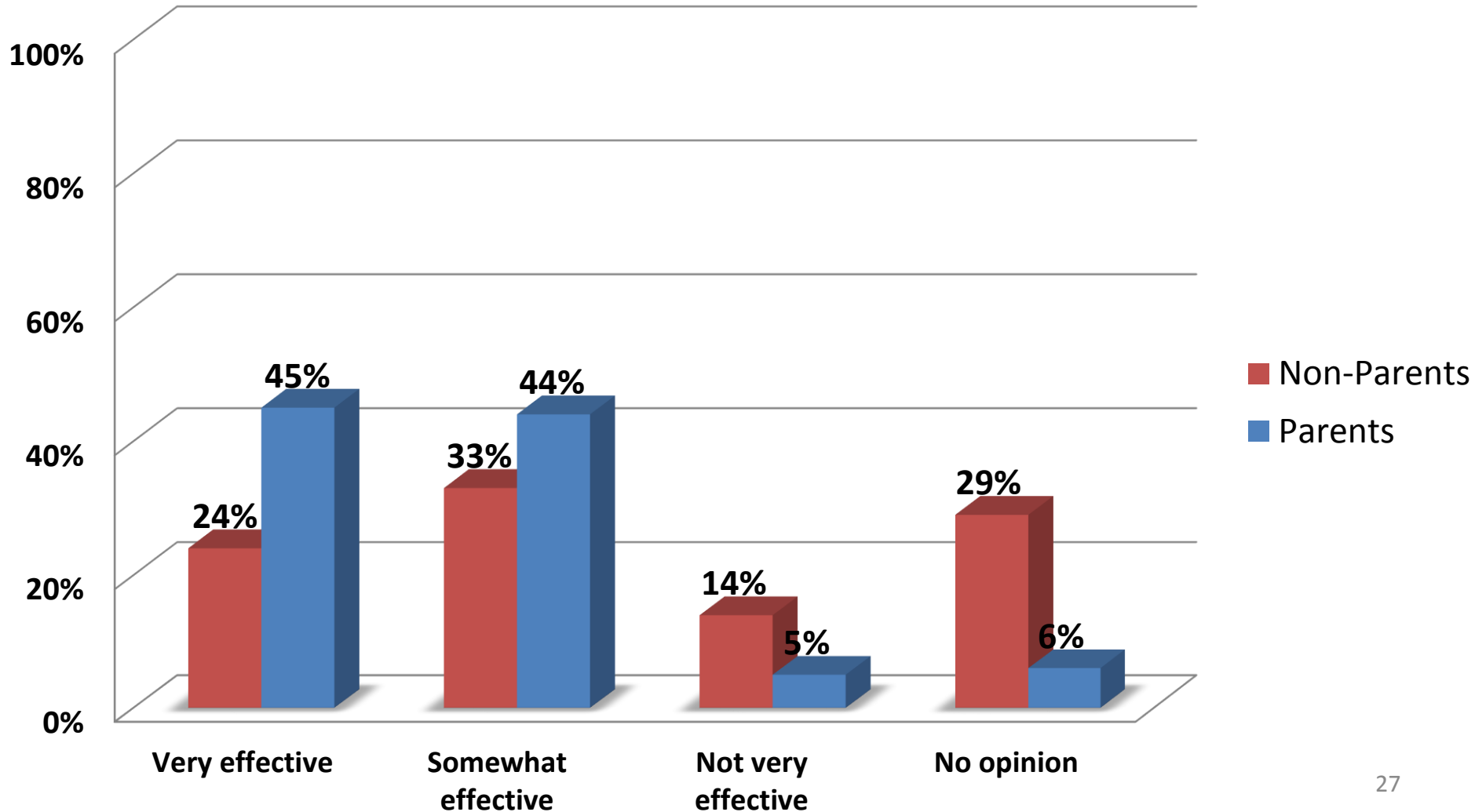
Which, if any, of the following forms of social media do you use?

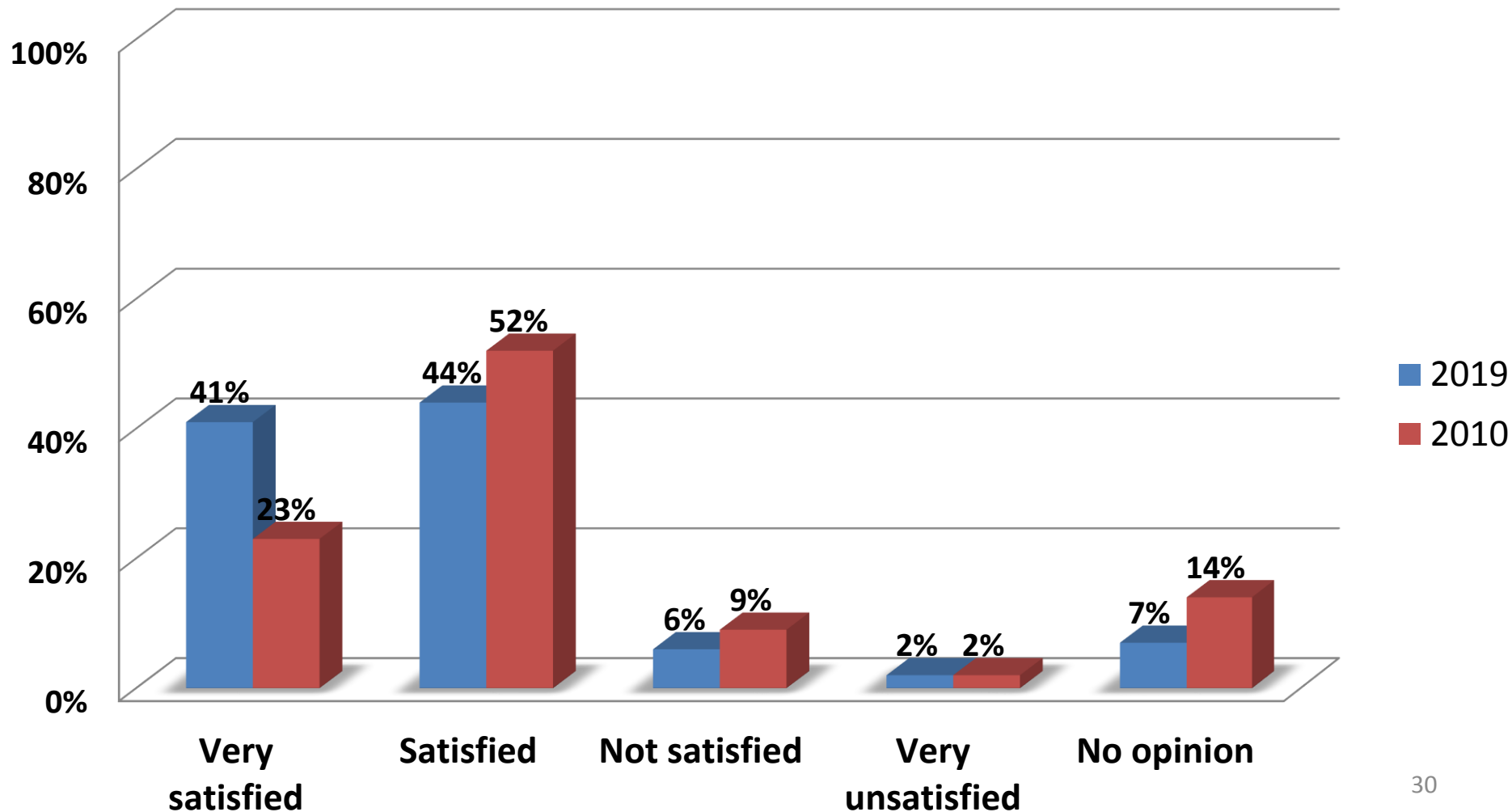
