Requirements:

- > Two scholarships awarded to two LDMS alumnus graduating from MHS.
- ➤ Dollar amount of \$500.00 each.
- Must have an overall GPA of at least 3.0 at MHS.
- Must not have any code violations while attending MHS, including parking violations. This is to enhance the values of respect and responsibility taught at LDMS.
- A short essay (300-350) words on how you have demonstrated respect and responsibility as a high school student.
- ➤ Is willing to be present at the LDMS eighth grade promotion ceremony (Thursday, June 11, 2020 7 PM). It is our hope that the scholarship winners' presence will plant a seed (in the minds of the current eighth grade students) about applying for and, potentially, being selected in four years when they graduate from MHS.
- ➤ Deadline to submit your application is <u>Wednesday</u>, <u>April 1, 2020</u> to MHS Student Services' Office.
- ➤ All applications are available in Student Services at MHS.
